

Next Generation Intern Job Description

PURPOSE:

To give the intern experience and responsibility in ministry.



Internship Qualifications:

- To be a member in good standing in an Evangelical Church.
- Have a growing relationship with Christ and other believers.
- Have a desire to lead in worship for the long-term.
- Willing to grow in the disciple making philosophy of FEFC (Gospel!)
- Relational Ability: Love for people including babies through college
- Speaking Ability preferred, but not required.
- Administrative ability. Able to support ministry volunteers and communicate to new families.
- Technical Ability. Reasonable knowledge of computers (email, websites, etc.)
- Availability: Roughly 5-10 hours per week. August - July (or as agreed upon) Holidays to be negotiated.

Internship Benefits:

- Weekly stipend
- Potential for college credit
- Individualized internship projects, based on skills and needs, for personal and professional development
- Directly mentored by the pastor
- Hands-on leadership experience
- Community of like-minded believers to encourage and support you
- Opportunity to play a role in seeing lives transformed by the Gospel
- Incredible amounts of fun!

Responsibilities:

- Meet with the pastor/ministry team for encouragement and feedback weekly (or as agreed upon).
- Develop next generation strategy with the pastor and teachers, including:
 - Improve Sunday Morning Children/Youth/College ministries. Consider mid-week program or retreats.
 - Occasional outreach activities (CEF after school clubs, Quarterly children, youth, college events)
 - Occasional parent/family disciple making opportunities. (service?)
- Coordinate communications with families and students, create congregational communication pieces.
- Welcome and communicate with new families
- Coordinate Sunday school teachers, other staff as needed
- Administrate the summer children's outreach ministry (if agreed upon)
- Meet with the pastor/ministry staff regularly (weekly or as otherwise decided upon)
- Other goals or tasks as agreed upon.
