

Worship Intern Job Description

PURPOSE:

To give the intern experience and responsibility in worship ministry.



Internship Qualifications:

- To be a member/attender in good standing in an Evangelical Church.
- Have a growing relationship with Christ and other believers.
- Have a desire to lead in worship for the long-term.
- Willing to grow in the worship philosophy of FEFC.
- Musical Ability. Able to play or sing
- Leadership Ability. Able to lead rehearsals and Sunday performance.
- Speaking Ability preferred, but not required.
- Administrative ability. Able to coordinate the worship schedule, including Planning Center and Easy Worship.
- Technical Ability. Reasonable knowledge of computers, sound, video, willingness to be trained.
- Availability: Roughly 5-10 hours per week. August - July. Holidays to be negotiated.

- Individualized internship projects, based on skills and needs, for personal and professional development
- Directly mentored by the pastor
- Hands-on leadership experience

Responsibilities:

- Meet with the pastor/ministry staff regularly (weekly or as otherwise decided upon)
- Co-plan and lead the Sunday worship gathering.
- Provide support, advise and coordinate resources for youth and children as needed
- Coordinate with the pastor and worship commission the oversight of the annual Music Ministry calendar, including organizing and promoting special events, (i.e. Palm Sunday, Good Friday, Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Baptismal Services, and additional prayer and praise services.
- Direct instrumental &/or vocal rehearsals
- Prepare music charts, both online and hard-copy versions (Audio files to PCO)
- Coordination of ministry announcement slides (optional)
- Recruit, audition and schedule vocal, instrumental, and tech folks. Play/sing as needed.
- Other goals or tasks as agreed upon.
